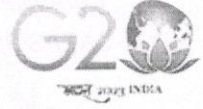

SI. No. GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The total number of section of the school shall be restricted to 31 (As per prescribed dimension) as per the number of class rooms reported during inspection and further increase shall be subjected to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye laws.

2. Compliance of the points no. 1 to 10 may be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal, failing which due action will be taken.

Sl. No.	CONDITIONS FOR COMPLIANCE
1	1. The total number of sections of the school shall be restricted to 31 of which not more than 1/3rd sections may be used for Senior secondary classes and further increase shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye laws subject to the availability of rooms of dimensions.500 ft.
2	2. The school is situated in a campus which has other educational institutions run by the society, also mentioned in the fire safety certificate submitted initially by the school. It is not clear whether the land certificate pertains to the school only or also includes other campuses. The school shall furnish a land certificate clarifying the total area of the school out of the total land held by the society and society resolution earmarking such land for the school from the total land owned by it. The school shall submit this certificate within 3 months on SARAS .
3	3. The school is not enclosed by a concrete boundary wall on all 4 sides. As seen in the video, on one side it is separated from another building only by an iron grill.. The school shall construct a concrete boundary wall of prescribed 6 ft height in its place within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS.
4	4. The composite science lab , which is mandatory for secondary level students is not as per norms, in terms of equipment and lay out. There is a table with charts, instead of workstations with proper utilities, exhaust fans and fire extinguisher.No storage area is seen. The school shall upgrade the composite lab as per the SoP issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance.
5	5.. The school has converted regular cubicles in washrooms into CWSN toilets, which are small and have no room for a wheelchair/walker to navigate.Signage is temporary.The school shall make provision for separate toilets for CWSN , boys, and girls on all floors, with proper permanent signage, indicating the floor number, as per norms of RPwD Act and guidelines issued by the Board within 3 months, and submit compliance on SARAS.
6	6. No ramp is seen at the entrance of the building or inside in the corridors leading to the play area which only has steps.The school shall construct ramps at both these places as per norms of RPwD Act and guidelines issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS.
7	7. failure to submit compliance for the above-mentioned points within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty against the school.
8	8. The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Bengaluru within 3 months and submit the compliance.
9	9. The school shall follow the SoPs of the Board for its labs, library and sports facilities.

10. The school shall not remove the videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website and renew all mandatory certificates from time to time.
